



## **Professor Tamati Reedy**

*Seminar topic: Ko te Reo te mauri o te mana Māori*

Professor Tamati Reedy of Ngāti Porou is a professional educationalist, academic, and former top public servant with a MA in English and a MA and PhD in Linguistics. Professor Reedy was a Fulbright Scholar serving as Associate Professor at the University of Alabama, USA, 1982 - 83. He was the Chief Executive and Secretary of the Department of Māori Affairs from 1983 to 1989 and was awarded the 1990 New Zealand Medal for public service.

Professor Reedy was appointed to the University of Waikato in 1996 as Foundation Dean and Professor to establish the new School of Māori and Pacific Development. He was awarded the title Emeritus Professor by the University of Waikato in December 2009. Professor Reedy was appointed to the Waitangi Tribunal in 2010.

## **Christine Allan**

*Seminar topic: Forensic Scientist – The impact of “P” on communities*

*12.00-1.00pm Wednesday 15 September 2010 at all University BRCSS sites*

Christine's talk will begin with an overview of the company she works for, ESR and its main areas of science work. She will then focus on forensic science and in particular clandestine laboratories. A clandestine laboratory is a covert illegal operation that produces a controlled substance through the modification of raw materials. In New Zealand, the most common illicit drug dealt with by ESR's clandestine laboratory team is 'P' or methamphetamine.

Christine Allan is an alumna of the University of Auckland, where she obtained a Master of Science degree with honours in forensic science and a Bachelor of Science degree in chemistry. Christine currently works as a forensic scientist at ESR (the Institute of Environmental Science and Research Ltd) in the clandestine laboratory team. She is a member of the NZ Forensic Science Society and the Henderson-Waitakere toastmasters club. Christine enjoys reading and catching up with friends and family and *tries* to get to the gym regularly.
